#### **What's New at Camille!**

- AIM language learning.. We will begin implementing the AIM Language Learning Program in our Kindergarten, Grade 1 and Grade 2 classrooms. Through this program authentic learning is achieved through the use of storytelling, gestures, active collaboration and repetition. High-frequency vocabulary, introduced with gestures and contextualized in stories, drama, songs and dance, allows students to rapidly achieve levels of oral and written proficiency rarely seen with conventional methods.

- This year Camille hosts a variety of lunch hours to support our school community as it continues to grow! Students have celebrated more opportunities to play on the playground equipment and more space to play!
