Bus Lanes/Parent Parking

Parent/visitor parking is located in the North-East parking lot. The north lot is for staff ONLY. Please do not park or drop off in the staff parking or bus lanes in the south parking lot!

GUEST AND VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP

All guests and volunteers entering the school to assist in a classroom must stop at the front desk. At the front counter there is a sign up sheet along with a name tag for each volunteer and guest. Name tags are to be worn while in the school. Prior to leaving the school, volunteers and guests are asked to sign out and return their name tag.

Please note that in order to volunteer in our school, you must have a criminal record check on file. We keep these on file for three years. A letter to the RCMP is available on our website under Parent or a paper copy can be picked up at the front office. Bringing this letter to the RCMP office gives you the benefit of obtaining your criminal record check at a minimal fee. Please see us at the office if you require further information.

For lunch visits with your child, please stop at the front desk to sign in. Due to noise consideration, we expect that your child invite ONE GUEST ONLY to have lunch with you.
