Dental Outreach of Red Deer

DOoR serves families with children from 5-18 years with lower income who do not have Alberta Child Health Benefits or other health benefits to cover dental treatment. Cafeteria

Our cafeteria is open for breakfast and at lunch time. Through this venue, a hot lunch program, for all students, is available.

Elementary and middle school students are able to access the cafeteria (walk ups) for breakfast and lunch for cash sales only.

Our school offers online ordering for the cafeteria. The link for cafeteria online ordering is: camille.hotlunches.net. Access Code = ECJL

Families are able to order the 'daily specials' along with the daily favourites ahead of time and pay online with Paypal.

Please note the deadline for any monthly online orders is 3 days prior to the date for the pre ordered meal (ex. If you want a meal for Sept 14, the order must be entered on line by Sept 11). Please note that Saturday and Sunday do not count as two days. So if you order on a Friday, that order is good for the following Wednesday. If you have an order where you've missed the 3 day deadline, no worries as you can bring in a paper order form (these are available online or at the

front office). Payments for the paper orders can be made with cash or a cheque made payable to RDCRS.

1st Reconciliation & 1st Eucharist Registration

Registration ONLINE is OPEN for 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist for students in Grades 2 and up. This includes students who would like to catch up with their sacraments (Grades 3-12). They need to be baptized in a recognized faith and would like to continue their faith journey in the Catholic Church.

Confirmation registration will open up November 29, 2021.

FREE All-Access Family Recreation Pass

At Camille, we are so excited for the opportunity to provide our students and their families with free access to the recreation centres in partnership with the City of Red Deer! **Sign out our *Family ALL Access Recreation Pass**, available for *all* families to borrow and valid for *all* [drop-in activities](#), at *all* of the city's recreation centres.

To borrow the Family Recreation Pass and to check availability, fill out an appointment slot on the **ECJL [Family Recreation Pass Booking Calendar](#)**. In the notes section, you must indicate the full name of your child who will be picking it up at the Learning Commons.

The pass will be signed out on a first come first served basis and must be **returned within 24 hours for the next booking** (ex. Signed out Monday and returned the next day, Tuesday morning). If the pass is signed out on a Friday it can be used for the weekend and returned Monday. If you would like to sign it out for two consecutive weekdays, you will need to make two consecutive bookings. Read our full letter [here](#).

School Fees

School fees are only for: Gr 5 Music (\$10), Gr 6-9 Options (\$20), and transportation fees, for those living less than 1.6 km, and between 1.6 and 2.4 km from the school. These fees were due in September.
