### CAFETERIA

Our school cafeteria will be up and running on Monday, September 12th for breakfast and lunch. Our students in Grades K-5 will not be able to do walk-up orders at lunchtime anymore. If your child brings money to purchase a lunch, their teachers will allow them to go to the cafeteria in the morning to order their lunch.

### TRANSPORTATION

Our transportation department has processed over 250 additional registration forms this week alone and are working tirelessly to get all students placed onto the correct bus route.
