Youth Advisory Team Opportunity - Advancing Climate Justice

The <u>Youth Climate Justice</u> project (funded by the European Research Council) involves research on children's climate/environmental leadership; examining how it is transforming human rights through cases, UN action, government lobbying, community activities and so on.

We're establishing a Young Advisory Team to help us make sure the research is designed in a way that will help children and young people to feel comfortable, supported and able to express themselves in ways that work best for them.

We are looking to have a team of **twelve Young Advisors**. We welcome applications from children and young people across the world who are:

- Between 8 and 17 years old;
- Can be part of the Advisory Team from June 2024 to June 2025;
- Interested in climate justice, children's rights, and making sure children and young people have their say.

We have created <u>this webpage</u> with all the links to the Information Pack for Children and Young People, Information for Supporting Adults, and Application Form. The deadline for applicants is **May 5th, 2024 at 5pm.**

A few notes:

- As our research focuses on case studies in Ireland, Nepal, Canada and South Africa, we especially welcome applications from children and young people living in these countries.
